#### **School Arrival and Information:**

- Students need to arrive on campus by Tuesday, September 3, 2024. Parents are welcome to accompany their sons to the school and help with settling them into their room that day.
- All travel plans should be sent to Miss Kate Nelson (kate.nelson@grandriver.org) no later than Friday, August 23, 2024. Contact Miss Nelson even if you plan to bring your son to campus.
- Students needing transportation from the airport or bus station may reach out to the school for assistance. There is a fee attached for school or local transportation services.
- All required documents have been or will be sent next week. Please look for those (medical forms, permissions) and have all completed and returned to GRA by your son's arrival at the school.
- Students may bring a small dorm size refrigerator for the room. The school will have refrigerators available for the student to purchase upon arrival on campus.
- The suggested list of items for your son to bring to campus is attached. This includes GRA polo shirts that are required to be worn during the school day. (These are available for purchase at the school).

## **Dormitory Guidelines:**

Rooms may be decorated in moderation and each student may decorate one wall, so he feels more at home. Please work with your son as he packs to bring less to school for the safety and well-being of everyone. The following guidelines will be enforced:

- 1. Desks, floors, beds, and closet areas will be neat and clean for weekly room inspections.
- 2. Belongings must fit in the provided cupboard space or other plastic containers that will fit under the bed or in the closet area.
- 3. Food must be stored in sealed plastic containers or in a refrigerator.
- 4. Please remember nothing can be permanently attached to the walls so Command strips or sticky

putty must be used to hang items. No double-sided tape.

- 5. Personal hygiene items must be kept in a portable tote for your son to take in and out of the bathroom daily (this makes keeping the bathrooms clean much easier for the students).
- 6. Dorm parents, faculty, assigned staff, and administration will work with the guys to help keep the rooms in compliance with the guidelines. If needed, a student may be asked to pack and store excess items in a safe location until they may be sent home.

Finally, we worked on updating student/parent handbooks this summer with current and vital information to help your family have the best experience possible at Grand River Academy®. The handbooks will be posted on the website during opening week. I encourage you to review the information with your son. A signed acknowledgement needs to be returned to the school upon arrival at campus for the school year.
